

A framework for independent listening

We are going to explore a framework to adapt to any time you want to do some listening practice by yourself in a structured way. Follow the steps below:

| 1. | Go to ted.com and choose a video that you think could interest you. TED is full of extremely |
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| | interesting videos on all sorts of topics and offers transcripts and subtitles in several languages |
| | (always in English, often in Italian) for all of its videos. If you're unsure about the level of difficulty, |
| | choose a video that is appropriate for your level on this <u>website</u> . Read the title of the video: what |
| | do you think the topic will be? Think of three concepts that might be mentioned during the video |
| | and write them here: |

| 2. | Watch the video without subtitles for the first time and try to understand the main ideas. Write |
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| | some notes here while you listen. Do not forget to make use of the visuals in the video to help you |
| | understand. Did they mention the concepts you brainstormed before listening? |

- 3. Now activate the English subtitles in the video and watch it again. Make notes here while you listen:
- 4. Compare your no-subtitle notes (question 2) to your English subtitle notes (question 3).
 - a. What percentage did you understand without subtitles?
 - b. What information did you get when you listened without subtitles? What kind of information did you miss?
 - c. Why do you think you missed this information?
- 5. Now watch the video one last time with Italian subtitles and write your notes here:
- 6. Compare your English subtitle notes to your Italian subtitle notes.
 - a. Did you miss or misunderstand any major or important ideas? Did you miss any minor details or specific examples?



- b. Why do you think you missed or misunderstood this information?
- 7. Now open the transcript of the video and choose one paragraph to focus on. Go to the <u>cloze test</u> <u>generator</u>, copy and paste the text into the text box and set the cloze test to every 7 words. The website will generate a cloze test for you. Watch the video and fill in the gaps.
- 8. Check your test against the full transcription:
 - a. How well did you do?
 - b. What was easy to hear and understand?
 - c. What was difficult to hear and understand?
